Step 1:

FAQs

1. How long do I have to complete a course?

In order for you to be properly credited with the CPD hours, all courses must be completed in **30 calendar days** (including the quiz).

2. Once I have completed a course on cpdonline do I need to add this course into my CPD Tracker?

No, after a cpdonline course has been successfully completed and Law Society staff verifies this, they will then manually enter the CPD hours into your tracker. Note this is done on a periodic basis. Please allow staff sufficient time to enter these hours, especially during peak year end times.

3. Do I have to use PayPal?

Registering online for a course with PayPal will allow you to gain access to the program as soon as payment has gone through, **no waiting**.

Alternatively, you may complete an enrolment form (found on the cpdonline home page) and submit your credit card details or a cheque for processing but programs will not be made available until payment is received.
