

INDEPENDENT ADJUDICATOR

As an Independent Adjudicator, you will be responsible for conducting comprehensive independent reviews of liability assessments. Availability for approximately 8 to 10 hours a week is required, these hours are flexible.

Responsibilities

- Review all relevant file information and make a liability decision after careful consideration of the *Highway Traffic Act*, Manitoba Public Insurance liability assessment charts, and relevant case law.
- Document the reasoning behind the decision made, recognizing the impact it will have on the overall assessment process.

- Bachelor of Law degree from a recognized Canadian (or equivalent) law school
- Call to the Manitoba Bar

Experience

- Minimum of four years practicing law
