Justice John Menzies, *Manitoba Court of Queen's Bench (General Division)*



The Honourable Mr. Justice John A. Menzies was born plain John Menzies in Morden Manitoba. After graduating from high school in Morden, he enrolled at the University of Winnipeg and after two years into his education there, he applied and was accepted into the Faculty of Law at the University of Manitoba. He graduated with his LLB in 1980 and articulated at the law firm of Westwood and Dykman in Morden.

After his Call to the Bar in 1981, he moved to Dauphin where he practised with Johnston, Oliphant, Van Buekenhout and Deans until August of 1996.

He practiced general litigation including criminal defence work and insurance litigation. He was also counsel for Parkland Child and Family Services beginning in 1986.

Mr. Justice Menzies was appointed to the Court of Queen's Bench (Family Division) in Brandon in 1996. In 1998, he was appointed to the General Division of the Court of Queen's Bench. In 1999 he was appointed a Deputy Judge of the territory of Nunavut and in 2009 a Deputy Judge of the territory of Yukon. He continues to sit as a Court of Queen's Bench Judge to date.

Mr. Justice John Menzies is also proud to report that he has been married to his wife Geri since 1985 and that they have three children.
