In 2002, she returned to work for Legal Aid in The Pas and in January 2007 became the Supervising Attorney of the Northlands Community Law Office, The Pas. In 2015 Annette moved to Winnipeg and joined the Willow Community Law Office of Legal Aid Manitoba. Annette joined the Family Law Section of the Civil Legal Services Branch on a short term from June 2016 to February 2017. In February 2017 Annette began working with the Child Protection Law Office and in May 2017 became the Supervising Attorney. Annette has had the opportunity to appear in all levels of court in Manitoba and successfully opposed one leave application to the Supreme Court of Canada.
