Tracy Morrow, *Justice Manitoba - Legal Services Branch, Family Law*

Tracy has a B.A. and LL.B. from the University of Manitoba and was called to the Bar in 1991 after articling with Manitoba Justice. She joined the Family Law Branch of Manitoba Justice as Crown Counsel in 1992, was appointed General Counsel in 2008 and became head of the Family Law Section, Legal Services Branch of Manitoba Justice in 2015.

Over the course of her career with Manitoba Justice, a substantial part of her work has been in the area of family support and enforcement, starting out as counsel for the Maintenance Enforcement Program and later focusing on inter-jurisdictional family support issues. Amongst other things, her work includes family law policy and legislative development; inter-governmental projects relating to family support and other family law issues; and, on a really good day, the opportunity to talk to people about interesting inter-jurisdictional issues.

Tracy had the privilege of participating as a member of the Canadian delegation in the 2003 – 2007 negotiations at the Hague that led to the conclusion of the 2007 Hague Convention on the International Recovery of Child Support and Other Forms of Family Maintenance. She continues to be involved in work relating to that Hague Convention as a co-chair of a federal-provincial-territorial Working Group addressing possible implementation of the Convention in Canada.
