NOTICE OF RESTRICTIONS

Pursuant to Section 68 of *The Legal Profession Act*, the Complaints Investigation Committee of The Law Society of Manitoba (the “**Society**”) has imposed restrictions on the practise of law by **JOHN LORING PATRICK SINCLAIR**.

Effective September 23, 2019, **JOHN LORING PATRICK SINCLAIR** must:

1. not act as attorney under a power of attorney instrument; and
2. with respect to the practice areas of wills, estates, trusts, guardianships, committeeships, or other fiduciary matters, and prior to the opening of any new file:
 - a. not act unless under the supervision of another practicing member of the Society, who has been approved by the Society to act as his supervisor (the “**Practice Supervisor**”);
 - b. not open and act on any new matter without the prior approval of the Practice Supervisor, which approval shall only be given upon the Practice Supervisor confirming that the matter is within John L.P. Sinclair’s competency to act;
 - c. meet with the Practice Supervisor once per week for the purpose of reviewing and discussing the open matters, including a review of the work requested and anticipated to be done; and
 - d. direct the Practice Supervisor to provide to the Law Society in a quarterly report a list of all files opened, identifying the type of work being done.
